



PRIVACY AND PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION POLICY

Section 1. General Provisions

The website <https://parasolka.family> (hereinafter referred to as the Website) is the property of Maryna Serhiivna Slobodianiuk (hereinafter referred to as the Company). All intellectual property on the Website belongs to the Company unless otherwise specified.

This Privacy and Personal Data Protection Policy (Privacy Policy) applies exclusively within the framework of the Website Terms of Use and does not extend to third-party websites.

This Privacy Policy defines a set of legal, administrative, organisational, technical, and other measures taken by the Company to preserve the confidentiality and protection of personal data of individuals — users of the Website who use its services — as well as information disclosed by customers through the Website.

The purpose of this Policy is to ensure an appropriate level of data protection and prevent uncontrolled public access to users' personal data.

The Company takes all possible measures to protect against all known threats as described in this section.

Section 2. Access to Personal Data

In order to fulfil the functions and objectives of the Website, the Company obtains permission to process users' personal data.

Users provide consent for the collection, processing, storage, and use of their personal data by checking the appropriate box during Website interaction.

Personal data collected, processed, and stored by the Company may include:

- Full name;
- Gender;
- City of residence;
- Date and place of birth;
- Contact details (phone number, email, etc.);
- Other geographic location data.

Section 3. Period and Storage of Personal Data

Personal data is stored by the Company indefinitely, unless otherwise specified by Ukrainian law or the user's request.

Section 4. Consumer Rights

Users have the right to:

- Know the source of their personal data collection;
- Receive information on the terms of access to their personal data;
- Access their personal data;
- Be informed whether their personal data is being processed;
- Object to the processing of their personal data.

Section 5. Disclosure of Confidential Information and Personal Data

The Company does not disclose users' personal data without their permission, unless required by law.

The Company has the right to share personal data in cases of public necessity or based on the user's written consent.

Section 6. Deletion and Removal of Personal Data

A user's personal data shall be deleted in the following cases:

- Termination of the legal relationship between the user and the Company;
- At the written request of the user;
- Based on a court decision or request of the Commissioner of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine on Human Rights.
